
Minneapolis Public Schools Enrollment Trends

Minneapolis Public Schools has seen enrollment decline in each of the last 8 years. Even before COVID-19, enrollment has been dropping. Since 2017, K12 enrollment has dropped 21% from well over 35,000 to less than 28,000. The largest decrease came in 2022 following the implementation of the Comprehensive District Design (CDD), which led to an 8% drop in K12 enrollment.



Enrollment declines have come especially strong from students of color. Since 2017, BIPOC enrollment has decreased by 26% compared to just 12% for White students. Enrollment declines have come most strongly from Black and/or African American students, with enrollment down 42%. Over 5,000 Black and/or African American students have left MPS in that span.
